

HOW TO PLANT A BAREROOT TREE

Thin off any broken branches and cut back healthy ones by half.

Apply 2-4" mulch on top of compost and fertilizer

Add fruit tree fertilizer and compost above root zone

Graft scar faces north

soil line

Do not mix compost in hole, rather top dress the tree once planted

Set the top of roots at soil line

Use garden fork to fracture sides of hole after digging

Sprinkle roots with mychorryzal inoculant
